### Effective Feedback:

Emphasising the importance of effective and individual student feedback and its impact on attainment and progression

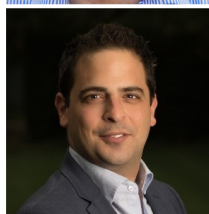

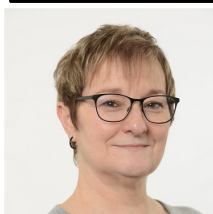
