



Background to Technical Education reforms

- Sainsbury Review/Post-16
 Skills Plan (2016)
- ✓ National system of qualifications
- ✓ Effective system of funding
- ✓ Good facilities and supply of teachers

New system of technical education structured around Apprenticeships and T Levels, underpinned by employer-designed occupational standards

Why the reforms matter

Still a disparity between academic and technical education routes

 UK falls behind most European countries when it comes to technical and vocational education

 Differentiation between qualifications designed to prepare learners for further study and those that prepare them for employment

Technical Education Programme

- What the CDI is doing to support the profession
- Funded by Gatsby, managed by CDI; £370 000 over 3 years

 To raise the profile of technical education amongst Careers Advisers so they are best placed to support young people with their choices

- Will provide resources and training
- A way of keeping up to date with technical education and reforms
